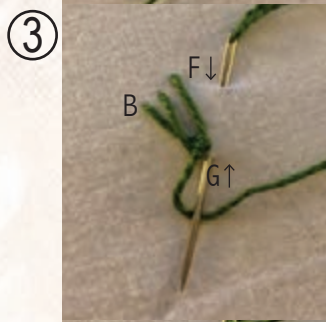
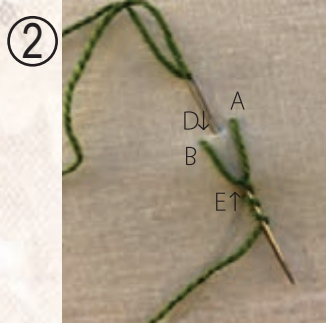
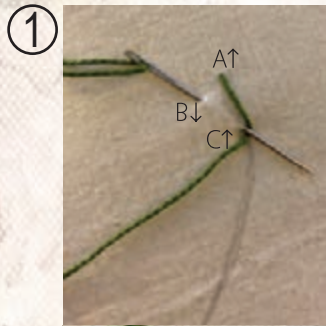


Fly Stitch Variation

This stitch is perfect for stems and branches, adding a bit of texture to a design.



1. Bring the needle and thread up at A at the top of the stitching line. Take the needle down at B to the left of the line and slightly below A. Bend the needle and bring it out at C. Take the working thread under the needle and pull through.

2. Take the needle down at D between A and B. Bend the needle and bring it up at E just below C. Wrap the working thread around the needle clockwise two times. Pull the needle through the wraps.

3. Take the needle down at F on the right side of the line and parallel to B. Bend the needle and bring it up at G on the line just below E. Take the working thread under the needle and pull through.

4. Take the needle down at H between A and F. Bend the needle and bring it up at I on the line just below G. Wrap the working thread around the needle clockwise two times. Pull the needle through the wraps.

5. First Fly Stitch Variation complete. Repeat Steps 1-4 the length of the line.
