

# Cast-on Stitch Rose & Petal Stitch Flowers

*The following are the supplies, order of stitching, and instructions for making the design below. ## **Supplies**

6-stranded embroidery floss for flowers, stems and leaves	7" x 7" square of fabric
#3 Milliners needle	5" embroidery hoop
#20 Chenille needle	1-1/2" piece of a straw
#22 Tapestry needle	1-1/2" pin

## **Rose**

**Stem:** 6 strands floss, Chenille needle, Stem Stitch

**Leaves:** 6 strands floss, Milliners needle, two Cast-on Stitches (see video and/or Stitch Tutorials), one on each side of the leaf, 9 wraps each

**Rose Center:** 6 strands floss, Tapestry needle, Spider Web Rose (see video and/or Stitch Tutorials) in 1/2" circle using three spokes

**Rose Petals:** 2 strands floss, Milliners needle, Cast-on Stitch with straw over needle (see video). Make three petals in each of the five sections. Petal 1 has 10 wraps, Petal 2 has 13 wraps, and Petal 3 has 15 wraps.

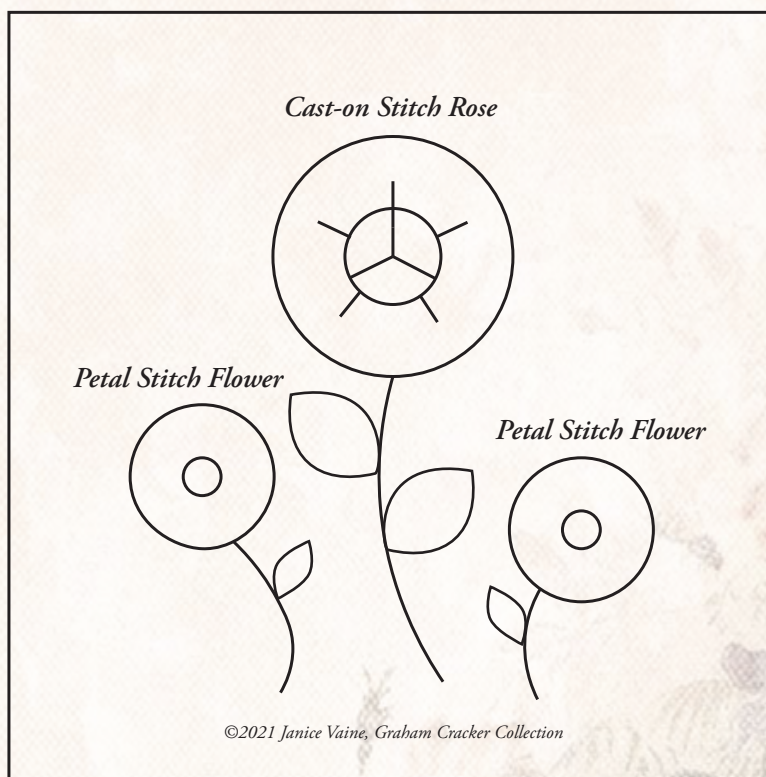
## **Petal Stitch Flower**

**Stems:** 3 strands floss, Chenille needle, Stem Stitch

**Leaves:** 6 strands floss, Chenille needle, Granitos Stitch (see video) with three stitches: middle, left and right

**Flowers:** 6 strands floss, Chenille needle, Petal Stitch (see video), four wraps per petal

**Flower Center:** 6 strands floss, Milliners needle, French Knot with three wraps
